# *RULES AND REGULATIONS*

1. **The conference schedule must be followed by everyone.**
2. Attendance at all meetings (including cabin times and morning revival) is mandatory. In case of sickness, appropriate medical attention will be obtained and parents may be asked to come take the sick child home.
3. During cabin times, everyone will be encouraged to participate.
4. No one may leave the camp grounds at any time.
5. No electronic items are allowed (cell phones, MP3/DVD/CD players, TV, tablets, radios, games, etc.). **Cell phones will be collected at the beginning of the conference and returned on Lord's Day morning. Please bring your printed Bible and hymn book to the meetings.**
6. No novels or magazines are permitted, only spiritual reading materials or homework. This includes the rides to and from the camp. Homework material may **not** include novels or other types of fiction.
7. Brothers are not permitted in the areas of the sisters' lodging, and sisters are not permitted in the areas the brothers are occupying.
8. All clothing worn during the entire weekend must be proper and modest. **No sleeveless, low cut, skin-tight or skin-revealing shirts may be worn. No shorts, pants that sag, hip-hugger or low rise pants may be worn. No clothing, caps, or shirts with improper pictures, logos, or symbols may be worn. This applies to brothers and sisters.** [Please read: Watchman Nee, *Messages for Building Up New Believers*, vol. 3, chapter 37].
9. All **Camp Regulations** must be observed. For example, no alcohol, tobacco, fireworks, firearms, knives, illegal drugs, flammable liquids, explosives, poisonous substances, or cliff climbing are permitted at the camp. *Fighting* – All forms of physical violence are expressly forbidden and are grounds for immediate expulsion of the offending parties and possible criminal charges being filed. *Profanity / Vulgar Speech* – will not be tolerated at any time.
10. Snacks and food are not allowed in the bedrooms.
11. Due to fire danger, candle usage will not be allowed in any building.
12. **All attendees must follow the instructions of the serving ones.**

# CHRIST IN ROMANS

Message One

## Christ is the Gospel of God and the Righteousness of God

**Romans 1:1, 3a** Paul, a slave of Christ Jesus, a called apostle, separated unto the gospel of God.... **3** Concerning His Son....

**Romans 1:9** For God is my witness, whom I serve in my spirit in the gospel of His Son, how unceasingly I make mention of you always in my prayers.

**Rom. 1:16–17** For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one who believes, both to Jew first and to Greek. **17** For the righteousness of God is revealed in it out of faith to faith, as it is written, “But the righteous shall have life and live by faith.”

**Romans 3:21a, 22** But now, apart from the law, the righteousness of God has been manifested.... **22** Even the righteousness of God through the faith of Jesus Christ to all those who believe, for there is no distinction.

**Romans 3:26** With a view to the demonstrating of His righteousness in the present time, so that He might be righteous and the One who justifies him who is of the faith of Jesus.

**Romans 5:5–8** And hope does not put us to shame, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us. **6** For while we were yet weak, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. **7** For scarcely for a righteous man will anyone die, though perhaps for the good man someone would even dare die. **8** But God commends His own love to us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

**Romans 8:3–4a** For that which the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God, sending His own Son in the likeness of the flesh of sin and concerning sin, condemned sin in the flesh, **4** That the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us....

**Psalms 89:14a** Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne....

**Romans 14:17** For the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

# CHRIST IN ROMANS

## Message Two

### Christ is the Propitiation Place

**Exo. 25:17–22** And you shall make an expiation cover of pure gold: two and a half cubits shall be its length, and one and a half cubits, its width.

**18** And you shall make two cherubim of gold; of beaten work you shall make them, at the two ends of the expiation cover.

**19** And make one cherub at one end and one cherub at the other end; of one piece with the expiation cover you shall make the cherubim on its two ends.

**20** And the cherubim shall spread out their wings above the cover, covering the expiation cover with their wings, with their faces toward one another; the faces of the cherubim shall be toward the expiation cover.

**21** And you shall put the expiation cover on top of the Ark, and into the Ark you shall put the testimony that I shall give you.

**22** And there I will meet with you, and I will speak with you from above the expiation cover, from between the two cherubim which are upon the Ark of the Testimony, of everything which I will give you in commandment to the children of Israel.

**Heb. 1:3** Who, being the effulgence of His glory and the impress of His substance and upholding and bearing all things by the word of His power, having made purification of sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high.

**Heb. 9:5** And above it cherubim of glory overshadowing the propitiation place, concerning which it is not now the time to speak in detail.

**Heb. 2:17** Hence He should have been made like His brothers in all things that He might become a merciful and faithful High Priest in the things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.

**Rom. 5:19** For just as through the disobedience of one man the many were constituted sinners, so also through the obedience of the One the many will be constituted righteous.

**Rom. 3:23–24** For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, **24** Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus.

**Rom. 3:25** Whom God set forth as a propitiation place through faith in His blood, for the demonstrating of His righteousness, in that in His forbearance God passed over the sins that had previously occurred.

**Rom. 5:17** For if by the offense of the one death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.

**Rom. 5:18** So then as it was through one offense unto condemnation to all men, so also it was through one righteous act unto justification of life to all men.

**Heb. 4:16** Let us therefore come forward with boldness to the throne of grace that we may receive mercy and find grace for timely help.

**Heb. 8:12** For I will be propitious to their unrighteousnesses, and their sins I shall by no means remember anymore.

**Isa. 53:5-6** But He was wounded because of our transgressions; He was crushed because of our iniquities; The chastening for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we have been healed. **6** We all like sheep have gone astray; Each of us has turned to his own way, And Jehovah has caused the iniquity of us all To fall on Him.

**1 Pet. 3:18** For Christ also has suffered once for sins, the Righteous on behalf of the unrighteous, that He might bring you to God, on the one hand being put to death in the flesh, but on the other, made alive in the Spirit.

**Phil. 3:9** And be found in Him, not having my own righteousness which is out of the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is out of God and based on faith.

**John 1:29** Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world.

**1 John 2:2** And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for those of the whole world.

**1 John 4:10** Herein is love, not that we have loved God but that He loved us and sent His Son as a propitiation for our sins.

Message Three

### Christ is the Indwelling One

**2 Corinthians 13:5** ...Or do you not realize about yourselves that Jesus Christ is in you....

**Romans 8:10** But if Christ is in you, though the body is dead because of sin, the spirit is life because of righteousness.

**Romans 8:6** For the mind set on the flesh is death, but the mind set on the spirit is life and peace.

**Romans 8:11** And if the Spirit of the One who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who indwells you.

**1 Thessalonians 5:23** And the God of peace Himself sanctify you wholly, and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame, at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

**Hebrews 4:12** For the word of God is living and operative and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing even to the dividing of soul and spirit and of joints and marrow, and able to discern the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

**Genesis 2:7** The Lord God formed man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and man became a living soul.

**1 Corinthians 15:45a** So also it is written, “The first man, Adam, became a living soul.”

**Job 32:8a** But there is a spirit in man....

**Proverbs 20:27** The spirit of man is the lamp of Jehovah, / Searching all the innermost parts of the inner being.

**John 4:24** God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truthfulness.

**Psalms 139:14b** ...And my soul knows it well.

**Song of Songs 1:7a** Tell me, you whom my soul loves....

**Job 7:15** So that my soul would choose....

**Romans 9:1** I speak the truth in Christ, I do not lie, my conscience bearing witness with me in the Holy Spirit.

**Romans 8:16** The Spirit Himself witnesses with our spirit that we are children of God.

**Romans 1:9** For God is my witness, whom I serve in my spirit in the gospel of His Son, how unceasingly I make mention of you always in my prayers.

**1 Corinthians 2:11a** For who among men knows the things of man, except the spirit of man which is in him?

**Hebrews 10:22b** ...having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water.

**Genesis 6:5** ...every imagination of the thoughts of his heart....

**John 16:22** ...but I will see you again and your heart will rejoice....

**Acts 11:23** ...purpose of heart.

**Romans 7:22** For I delight in the law of God according to the inner man.

**Romans 7:23** But I see a different law in my members, warring against the law of my mind and making me a captive to the law of sin which is in my members.

**Romans 8:2** For the law of the Spirit of life has freed me in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and of death.

**Romans 8:9a** But you are not in the flesh, but in the spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you.

**Ephesians 3:17a** That Christ may make His home in your hearts through faith....

**Colossians 3:16a** Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly....

**Psalms 119:11** In my heart I have treasured up Your word / That I might not sin against You.

Message Four

### Christ is the Olive Tree

**Romans 6:3–6** Or are you ignorant that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death?

**4** We have been buried therefore with Him through baptism into His death, in order that just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so also we might walk in newness of life.

**5** For if we have *grown together with Him* in the likeness of His death, indeed we will also be in the likeness of His resurrection,

**6** Knowing this, that our old man has been crucified with Him in order that the body of sin might be annulled, that we should no longer serve sin as slaves....

**Romans 6:12–13** Do not let sin therefore reign in your mortal body so that you obey the body's lusts; **13** Neither present your members as weapons of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as alive from the dead, and your members as weapons of righteousness to God....

**Romans 6:16** Do you not know that to whom you present yourselves as slaves for obedience, his slaves you are whom you obey, whether of sin unto death or of obedience unto righteousness?...

**Romans 6:19** I speak in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented your members as slaves to uncleanness and lawlessness unto lawlessness, so now present your members as slaves to righteousness unto sanctification.



**Romans 11:17** But if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were *grafted in* among them and became a fellow partaker of the root of fatness of the olive tree.

**Romans 8:1** There is now then no condemnation to those who are *in Christ Jesus*.

**2 Cor. 5:17** So then if anyone is *in Christ*, he is a new creation. The old things have passed away; behold, they have become new.

**Col. 1:14** *In whom* we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

**2 Cor. 5:21** Him who did not know sin He made sin on our behalf that we might become the righteousness of God *in Him*.

**Romans 8:2** For the law of the Spirit of life has freed me *in Christ Jesus* from the law of sin and of death.

## CHRIST IN ROMANS

Message Five

### Christ is the Servant

**Romans 12:1–8** I exhort you therefore, brothers, through the compassions of God to present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, well pleasing to God, which is your reasonable service.

**2** And do not be fashioned according to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of the mind that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and well pleasing and perfect.

**3** For I say, through the grace given to me, to every one who is among you, not to think more highly of himself than he ought to think, but to think so as to be sober-minded, as God has apportioned to each a measure of faith.

**4** For just as in one body we have many members, and all the members do not have the same function,

**5** So we who are many are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another.

**6** And having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith;

**7** Or service, let us be faithful in that service; or he who teaches, in that teaching;

**8** Or he who exhorts, in that exhortation; he who gives, in simplicity; he who leads, in diligence; he who shows mercy, in cheerfulness.

**Romans 15:1–3** But we who are strong ought to bear the weaknesses of those who are weak and not to please ourselves.

2 Let each of us please his neighbor with a view to what is good for building up.

3 For Christ also did not please Himself, but as it is written, “The reproaches of those who reproached You fell upon Me.”

**Romans 15:8–11** For I say that Christ has become a servant of the circumcision for the sake of God's truthfulness, to confirm the promises given to the fathers, 9 And that the Gentiles should glorify God for His mercy, as it is written, “Therefore I will extol You among the Gentiles, and I will sing praise to Your name.” 10 And again he says, “Rejoice, Gentiles, with His people.” 11 And again, “Praise the Lord, all you Gentiles, and let all the peoples speak praise to Him.”

1 **Corinthians 14:29–32** And as to prophets, two or three should speak, and the others discern. 30 But if something is revealed to another sitting by, the first should be silent. 31 For you can all prophesy one by one that all may learn and all may be encouraged. 32 And the spirits of prophets are subject to prophets.
