- 8. All clothing worn during the entire weekend must be proper and modest. No sleeveless, low cut, skin-tight or skin-revealing shirts may be worn. No shorts, pants that sag, hip-hugger or low rise pants may be worn. No clothing, caps, or shirts with improper pictures, logos, or symbols may be worn. This applies to brothers and sisters. [Please read: Watchman Nee, Messages for Building Up New Believers, vol. 3, chapter 37].
- 9. All Camp Regulations must be observed. For example, no alcohol, tobacco, fireworks, firearms, knives, illegal drugs, flammable liquids, explosives, poisonous substances, or cliff climbing are permitted at the camp. Fighting All forms of physical violence are expressly forbidden and are grounds for immediate expulsion of the offending parties and possible criminal charges being filed. Profanity / Vulgar Speech will not be tolerated at any time.
- 10. Snacks and food are not allowed in the bedrooms.
- 11. Due to fire danger, candle usage will not be allowed in any building.
- 12. All attendees must follow the instructions of the serving ones.

Message One

An Overcomer is a Lover

- **Revelation 1:1** The revelation of Jesus Christ which God gave to Him to show to His slaves...
- **Rev. 1:3** Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of the prophecy and keep the things written in it, for the time is near.
- **Rev. 1:9** I John, your brother and fellow partaker in the tribulation and kingdom and endurance in Jesus, was on the island called Patmos because of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus.
- **Revelation 1:10** I was in spirit on the Lord's Day and heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet.
- Revelation 1:12–18 And I turned to see the voice that spoke with me; and when I turned, I saw seven golden lampstands, 13 And in the midst of the lampstands One like the Son of Man, clothed with a garment reaching to the feet, and girded about at the breasts with a golden girdle. 14 And His head and hair were as white as white wool, as snow; and His eyes were like a flame of fire; 15 And His feet were like shining bronze, as having been fired in a furnace; and His voice was like the sound of many waters. 16 And He had in His right hand seven stars; and out of His mouth proceeded a sharp two-edged sword; and His face shone as the sun shines in its power. 17 And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead; and He placed His right hand on me, saying, Do not fear; I am the First and the Last 18 And the living One; and I became dead, and behold, I am living forever and ever; and I have the keys of death and of Hades.
- Revelation 2:1-7 To the messenger of the church in Ephesus write: These things says He who holds the seven stars in His right hand, He who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands: 2 I know your works and your labor and your endurance and that you cannot bear evil men; and you have tried those who call themselves apostles and are not, and have found them to be false; [3 And you have endurance and have borne all things because of My name and have not grown weary.] 4 But I have one thing against you, that you have left your first love. 5 Remember therefore where you have fallen from and repent and do the first works; but if not, I am coming to you and will remove your lampstand out of its place, unless you repent. [6 But this you have, that you hate the works of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.] 7 He who has an ear, let him hear

what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes, to him I will give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the Paradise of God.

- **Isa. 50:4** The Lord Jehovah has given me / The tongue of the instructed, / That I should know how to sustain the weary with a word. / He awakens me morning by morning; / He awakens my ear / To hear as an instructed one.
- **Eph. 3:17** That Christ may make His home in your hearts through faith, that you being rooted and grounded in love.

An Overcomer is Faithful

- Revelation 2:8–11 And to the messenger of the church in Smyrna write: These things says the First and the Last, who became dead and lived again: 9 I know your tribulation and poverty (but you are rich) and the slander from those who call themselves Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan. 10 Do not fear the things that you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil is about to cast some of you into prison that you may be tried, and you will have tribulation for ten days. Be faithful unto death, and I will give you the crown of life. 11 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. He who overcomes shall by no means be hurt of the second death.
- **Dan. 1:8** But Daniel set his heart not to defile himself with the king's choice provision and with the wine that the king drank, so he requested of the leader of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.
- **Dan. 6:4** Then the chief ministers and satraps sought to find a ground for accusation against Daniel from the perspective of the kingdom, but they could find no ground for accusation or fault, inasmuch as he was faithful, and no negligence or fault was found related to him.
- **Matt. 24:45** Who then is the faithful and prudent slave, whom the master has set over his household to give them food at the proper time?

To him who overcomes, to him I will give of the hidden manna, and to him I will give a white stone, and upon the stone a new name written, which no one knows except him who receives it.

- 1 Pet. 2:2–3 As newborn babes, long for the guileless milk of the word in order that by it you may grow unto salvation, 3 If you have tasted that the Lord is good.
- 2 Pet. 2:15 Forsaking the straight way, they have gone astray, following the way of Balaam, the son of Beor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness.

- **Eph. 5:1–2** Be therefore imitators of God, as beloved children; *2* And walk in love, even as Christ also loved us and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling savor.
- **Eph. 5:15–16** Look therefore carefully how you walk, not as unwise, but as wise, *16* Redeeming the time, because the days are evil.

Message Three

An Overcomer is Exercised

Rev. 2:18–29 And to the messenger of the church in Thyatira write: These things says the Son of God, He who has eyes like a flame of fire, and His feet are like shining bronze: 19 I know your works and love and faith and service and your endurance and that your last works are more than the first. 20 But I have something against you, that you tolerate the woman Jezebel, she who calls herself a prophetess and teaches and leads My slaves astray to commit

fornication and to eat idol sacrifices. 21 And I gave her time that she might repent, and she is not willing to repent of her fornication. 22 Behold, I cast her into a bed, and those who commit adultery with her, into great tribulation, unless they repent of her works; 23 And her children I will kill with death; and all the churches will know that I am He who searches the inward parts and the hearts; and I will give to each one of you according to your works. 24 But I say to you—the rest in Thyatira, as many as do not have this teaching, who have not known the deep things of Satan, as they say—I put no other burden upon you; 25 Nevertheless what you have hold fast until I come. 26 And he who overcomes and he who keeps My works until the end, to him I will give authority over the nations; 27 And he will shepherd them with an iron rod, as vessels of pottery are broken in pieces, as I also have received from My Father; 28 And to him I will give the morning star. 29 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

Rev. 3:1-6 And to the messenger of the church in Sardis write: These things says He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars: I know your works, that you have a name that you are living, and yet you are dead. 2 Become watchful and establish the things which remain, which were about to die; for I have found none of your works completed before My God. 3 Remember therefore how you have received and heard, and keep it and repent. If therefore you will not watch, I will come as a thief, and you shall by no means know at what hour I will come upon you. 4 But you have a few names in Sardis who have not defiled their garments, and they will walk with Me in white because they are worthy. 5 He who overcomes will be clothed thus, in white garments, and I shall by no means erase his name out of the book of life, and I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels. 6 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

Matt. 25:1 At that time the kingdom of the heavens will be likened to ten virgins, who took their lamps and went forth to meet the bridegroom.

Matt. 25:4 But the prudent took oil in their vessels with their lamps.

Matt. 25:13 Watch therefore, for you do not know the day nor the hour.

- 7 Purge my sin with hyssop, and I will be clean; Wash me, and I will be whiter than snow. 8 Let me hear gladness and joy, That the bones which You have broken may exult. 9 Hide Your face from my sins, And blot out all my iniquities. 10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me. 11 Do not cast me from Your presence, And do not take the Spirit of Your holiness away from me. 12 Restore to me the gladness of Your salvation, And sustain me with a willing spirit. 13 I will teach transgressors Your ways, And sinners will turn back to You. 14 Deliver me from the guilt of bloodshed, O God, O God of my salvation; And my tongue will ring forth Your righteousness.
- **Rev. 12:11** And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they loved not their soul-life even unto death.
- Rev. 7:14 And I said to him, My lord, you know. And he said to me, These are those who come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

An Overcomer Pays the Price

Rev. 3:7-13 And to the messenger of the church in Philadelphia write: These things says the Holy One, the true One, the One who has the key of David, the One who opens and no one will shut, and shuts and no one opens: 8 I know your works; behold, I have put before you an opened door which no one can shut, because you have a little power and have kept My word and have not denied My name. 9 Behold, I will make those of the synagogue of Satan, those who call themselves Jews and are not, but lie—behold, I will cause them to come and fall prostrate before your feet and to know that I have loved you. 10 Because you have kept the word of My endurance, I also will keep you out of the hour of trial, which is about to come on the whole inhabited earth, to try them who dwell on the earth. 11 I come quickly; hold fast what you have that no one take your crown. 12 He who overcomes, him I will make a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall by no means go out anymore, and I will write upon him the name of My God and the name of the city of My God, the New Jerusalem, which descends out of heaven from My God, and My new name. 13 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

Rev. 3:14-22 And to the messenger of the church in Laodicea write: These things says the Amen, the faithful and true Witness, the beginning of the creation of God: 15 I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot; I wish that you were cold or hot. 16 So, because you are lukewarm and neither hot nor cold, I am about to spew you out of My mouth. 17 Because you say, I am wealthy and have become rich and have need of nothing, and do not know that you are wretched and miserable and poor and blind and naked, 18 I counsel you to buy from Me gold refined by fire that you may be rich, and white garments that you may be clothed and that the shame of your nakedness may not be manifested, and eyesalve to anoint your eyes that you may see. 19 As many as I love I reprove and discipline; be zealous therefore and repent. 20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if anyone hears My voice and opens the door, then I will come in to him and dine with him and he with Me. 21 He who overcomes, to him I will give to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat with My Father on His throne. 22 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

1 Cor. 9:24-25 Do you not know that those who run on a racecourse all run, but one receives the prize? Run in this way, that you may lay hold. 25 And everyone who contends exercises self-control in all

things; they then, that they may receive a corruptible crown, but we, an incorruptible.

- **2 Tim. 2:22** But flee youthful lusts, and pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.
- **Phil. 3:8** But moreover, I also count all things to be loss on account of the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, on account of whom I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as refuse that I may gain Christ.
