# *RULES AND REGULATIONS*

1. **The conference schedule must be followed by everyone.**
2. Attendance at all meetings (including cabin times and morning revival) is mandatory. In case of sickness, appropriate medical attention will be obtained and parents may be asked to come take the sick child home.

5. No electronic items are allowed (cell phones, MP3/DVD/CD players, TV, tablets, radios, games, etc.). **Cell phones will be collected at the beginning of the conference and returned on Lord's Day morning. Please bring your printed Bible and hymn book to the meetings.**
6. No novels or magazines are permitted, only spiritual reading materials or homework. This includes the rides to and from the camp. Homework material may **not** include novels or other types of fiction.
7. Brothers are not permitted in the areas of the sisters' lodging, and sisters are not permitted in the areas the brothers are occupying.
8. All clothing worn during the entire weekend must be proper and modest. **No sleeveless, low cut, skin-tight or skin-revealing shirts may be worn. No shorts, pants that sag, hip-hugger or low rise pants may be worn. No clothing, caps, or shirts with improper pictures, logos, or symbols may be worn. This applies to brothers and sisters.** [Please read: Watchman Nee, *Messages for Building Up New Believers*, vol. 3, chapter 37].
9. All **Camp Regulations** must be observed. For example, no alcohol, tobacco, fireworks, firearms, knives, illegal drugs, flammable liquids, explosives, poisonous substances, or cliff climbing are permitted at the camp. *Fighting* – All forms of physical violence are expressly forbidden and are grounds for immediate expulsion of the offending parties and possible criminal charges being filed. *Profanity / Vulgar Speech* – will not be tolerated at any time.
10. Snacks and food are not allowed in the bedrooms.
11. Due to fire danger, candle usage will not be allowed in any building.
12. **All attendees must follow the instructions of the serving ones.**

Message One

## The Battle for God's Image and Dominion

**Gen. 1:26-27** And God said, Let Us make man in Our **image**, according to Our likeness; and let them have **dominion** over the fish of the sea and over the birds of heaven and over the cattle and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth. **27** And God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

**Gen. 2:8-9** And Jehovah God planted a garden in Eden, in the east; and there He put the man whom He had formed. **9** And out of the ground Jehovah God caused to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight and good for food, as well as **the tree of life** in the middle of the garden and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

**Gen. 2:15** And Jehovah God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to work it and **to keep it** (*to guard it*).

**Gen. 3:24** So He drove the man out, and at the east of the garden of Eden He placed the cherubim and a flaming sword which turned in every direction to guard the way to the tree of life.

**Exo. 40:34** Then the cloud covered the Tent of Meeting, and the **glory** of Jehovah filled the tabernacle.

**Num. 1:2-3** Take the sum of all the assembly of the children of Israel, by their families, by their fathers' households, according to the number of names, every male, head by head. **3** From twenty years old and upward, all who are able to go forth for **military service** in Israel, you and Aaron shall number them by their companies.

**1 Kings 5:4** But now Jehovah my God has given me rest all around; there is **no adversary** or evil occurrence.

**1 Ki. 8:11** And the priests were not able to stand and minister because of the cloud, for the **glory** of Jehovah filled the house of Jehovah.

**2 Kings 24:10** At that time the servants of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon went up to Jerusalem, and the city came under siege.

**2 Kings 24:13-14** And he brought out from there all the treasures of the house of Jehovah and the treasures of the king's house. And he cut in pieces all the golden vessels which Solomon the king of Israel had made in Jehovah's temple, as Jehovah had said. **14** And he carried away into exile all Jerusalem and all the captains and all the mighty men of valor, ten thousand captives, and all the craftsmen and smiths....

**2 Kings 25:9–10** And he burned the house of Jehovah and the king's house and all the houses of Jerusalem, and every large house he burned with fire. **10** And all the army of the Chaldeans who were with the captain of the bodyguard broke down the walls around Jerusalem.

**Matt. 6:9–13** You then pray in this way: Our Father who is in the heavens, **Your name be sanctified;** **10 Your kingdom come;** Your will be done, as in heaven, so also on earth. **11** Give us today our daily bread. **12** And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. **13** And do not bring us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the **kingdom** and the power and the **glory** forever. Amen.

**Rev. 1:6** And made us a **kingdom**, priests to His God and Father, to Him be the **glory** and the might forever and ever. Amen.

**Rev. 11:15** And the seventh angel trumpeted; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, The kingdom of the world has become the **kingdom** of our Lord and of His Christ, and He will **reign** forever and ever.

**Rev. 21:10–11a** And he carried me away in spirit onto a great and high mountain and showed me the holy city, Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, **11** Having the **glory** of God....

Message Two

### God's Need for Young People to Turn the Age

**Num. 6:1–2** Then Jehovah spoke to Moses, saying, **2** Speak to the children of Israel and say to them, When a man or a woman makes a special vow, the vow of a Nazarite, to separate himself to Jehovah.

**Daniel 1:8–9a** But Daniel set His heart not to defile himself with the king's choice provision and with the wine that the king drank, so he requested of the leader of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself. **9** And God granted Daniel favor and compassion....

**Eph. 4:20–21** But you did not so learn Christ, **21** If indeed you have heard Him and have been taught in Him as the reality is in Jesus.

**John 6:57** As the living Father has sent Me and I live because of the Father, so he who eats Me, he also shall live because of Me.

**Isaiah 7:15** He will eat curds and honey until he knows how to refuse evil and choose good.

**Psalm 73:25–26** Whom do I have in heaven but You? / And besides You there is nothing I desire on earth. / **26** My flesh and my heart fail, / But God is the rock of my heart and my portion forever.

**James 4:4** ...do you not know that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? Therefore whoever determines to be a friend of the world is constituted an enemy of God.

**1 John 2:15** Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father is not in him.

**2 Tim. 2:22** But flee youthful lusts, and pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

**Song of Songs 1:2** Let him kiss me with the kisses of his mouth! For your love is better than wine.

**Ephesians 5:18–20** And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissoluteness, but be filled in spirit, **19** Speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and psalming with your heart to the Lord, **20** Giving thanks at all times for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to our God and Father.

**1 Sam. 3:4** Then Jehovah called Samuel. And he said, Here I am.

**1 Sam. 3:10** Then Jehovah came and stood by and called as the other times, Samuel! Samuel! And Samuel said, Speak, for Your servant is listening.

**1 Sam. 3:19** And Samuel grew, and Jehovah was with him and let none of his words fall to the ground.

**Heb. 11:24–26** By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, **25** Choosing rather to be ill-treated with the people of God than to have the temporary enjoyment of sin, **26** Considering the reproach of the Christ greater riches than the treasures of Egypt; for he looked away to the reward.

### Message Three

### The Characteristics of Young People who Turn the Age

**Dan. 1:1–2** In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim the king of Judah Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon came to Jerusalem and besieged it. **2** And the Lord gave Jehoiakim the king of Judah into his hand with some of the vessels of the house of God; and he brought them into the land of Shinar to the house of his god, and he brought the vessels into the treasury of his god.

**Dan. 1:3–5** Then the king told Ashpenaz, the chief of his eunuchs, to bring some of the sons of Israel, including some from the royal seed and from the nobility, <sup>4</sup> Children in whom was no defect, who were good in appearance, who showed insight in all wisdom, understanding in knowledge, and apprehension in thought, and in whom was the ability to stand in the king's palace. And he told him to teach them the learning and language of the Chaldeans. <sup>5</sup> And the king appointed to them a daily portion from the king's choice provision and from the wine that he drank, and appointed that they should be brought up for three years so that at the end of the time they might stand before the king.

**Dan. 1:8** But Daniel set his heart not to defile himself with the king's choice provision and with the wine that the king drank, so he requested of the leader of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.

**Lev. 11:1–2** Then Jehovah spoke to Moses and to Aaron, saying to them, <sup>2</sup> Speak to the children of Israel, saying, These are the animals which you may eat among all the beasts that are on the earth.

**Lev. 11:4** However these you shall not eat...

**Lev. 11:44–45** For I am Jehovah your God. Sanctify yourselves therefore, and be holy, for I am holy. And you shall not defile yourselves.... *45b* ...you shall therefore be holy, for I am holy.

**Jer. 25:11** And this whole land will become a desolation and a waste, and these nations will serve the king of Babylon seventy years.

**Jer. 29:10** For thus says Jehovah, When seventy years are fulfilled for Babylon, I will visit you and establish My good word to you, to bring you back to this place.

**Dan. 2:17–18** Then Daniel went to his house and made the thing known to Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah, his companions, <sup>18</sup> That they might request compassions from before the God of the heavens concerning this mystery so that Daniel and his companions would not be destroyed with the rest of the wise men of Babylon.

**Dan. 6:10–11** Now when Daniel came to know that the writing had been signed, he went to his house (in his upper room he had windows open toward Jerusalem) and three times daily he knelt on his knees and prayed and gave thanks before his God, because he had always done so previously. <sup>11</sup> Then these men assembled and found Daniel making petition and supplication before his God.

**Dan. 9:1–4** In the first year of Darius..., **2** in the first year of his reign, I, Daniel, understood by means of the Scriptures the number of the years, which came as the word of Jehovah to Jeremiah the prophet, for the completion of the desolations of Jerusalem, that is, seventy years. **3** So I set my face toward the Lord God to seek Him in prayer and supplications with fasting and sackcloth and ashes. **4a** And I prayed to Jehovah my God and confessed....

**Dan. 9:20** And while I was still speaking and praying and confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel and presenting my supplication before Jehovah my God....

**Dan. 9:17** And now hear, O our God, the prayer of Your servant and his supplications, and cause Your face to shine upon Your sanctuary that has been desolated, for the Lord's sake.

**Dan. 3:16–18** Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, there is no need for us to give you an answer in this matter. **17** If it be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the blazing furnace of fire, and He will deliver us out of your hand, O king. **18** But if He does not, let it be known to you, O king, that we will not serve your gods nor worship the golden image that you have set up.

Message Four

### The Vow of the Nazarite

**Num. 6:2** Speak to the children of Israel and say to them, When a man or a woman makes a special vow, the vow of a Nazarite, to separate himself to Jehovah.

**Mark 12:30** And you shall love the Lord your God from your whole heart and from your whole soul and from your whole mind and from your whole strength.

**1 Pet. 2:9** But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people acquired for a possession, so that you may tell out the virtues of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.

**1 John 2:15–17** Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father is not in him; **16** Because all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the vainglory of life, is not of the Father but is of the world. **17** And the world is passing away, and its lust, but he who does the will of God abides forever.



**1 John 5:4** For everything that has been begotten of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory which has overcome the world — our faith.

**James 4:4** Adulteresses, do you not know that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? Therefore whoever determines to be a friend of the world is constituted an enemy of God.

**1 Tim. 5:6** But she who gives herself to pleasure is dead while living.

**Heb. 13:13** Let us therefore go forth unto Him outside the camp, bearing His reproach.

**1 Cor. 11:14** Does not even nature itself teach you that if a man has long hair, it is a dishonor to him.

**Exo. 19:5** Now therefore if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be My peculiar treasure from among all peoples, for all the earth is Mine.

**1 Tim. 2:1, 3–4** I exhort therefore, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercessions, thanksgivings be made on behalf of all men. **3** This is good and acceptable in the sight of our Savior God, **4** Who desires all men to be saved and to come to the full knowledge of the truth.

**Acts 1:8a** But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you shall be My witnesses...

**Acts 4:31, 33** And when they had so besought, the place in which they were gathered was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak the word of God with boldness. **33** And with great power the apostles gave testimony of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and great grace was upon them all.
