RULES AND REGULATIONS

- **7.** Brothers are not permitted in the areas of the sisters' lodging, and sisters are not permitted in the areas the brothers are occupying.
- 8. All clothing worn during the entire weekend must be proper and modest. No sleeveless, low cut, skin-tight or skin-revealing shirts may be worn. No shorts, pants that sag, hip-hugger or low rise pants may be worn. No clothing, caps, or shirts with improper pictures, logos, or symbols may be worn. This applies to brothers and sisters. - 9. All Camp Regulations must be observed. For example, no alcohol, tobacco, fireworks, firearms, knives, illegal drugs, flammable liquids, explosives, poisonous substances, or cliff climbing are permitted at the camp. Fighting All forms of physical violence are expressly forbidden and are grounds for immediate expulsion of the offending parties and possible criminal charges being filed. Profanity / Vulgar Speech will not be tolerated at any time.
- 10. Snacks and food are not allowed in the bedrooms.
- 11. Due to fire danger, candle usage will not be allowed in any building.
- 12. All attendees must follow the instructions of the serving ones.

Message One

The Speaking Blood

- **Rom. 3:10–12** Even as it is written, "There is none righteous, not even one; There is none who understands, there is none who seeks out God. All have turned aside; together they have become useless; there is none who does good; there is not so much as one.
- Rom. 3:23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. [M]
- Rom. 7:18, 23 For I know that in me, that is, in my flesh, nothing good dwells; for to will is present with me, but to work out the good is not...23 But I see a different law in my members, warring against the law of my mind and making me a captive to the law of sin which is in my members.
- **Luke 15:18b–19a** ... Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you; I am no longer worthy to be called your son....
- Genesis 3:8–9 And they heard the sound of Jehovah God walking about in the garden in the cool of the day, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of Jehovah God among the trees of the garden. 9 And the Jehovah God called to the man, and said to him, Where are you?
- Isaiah 59:1-2 No, Jehovah's hand is not so short that it cannot save; Nor is his ear so heavy, that it cannot hear. But your iniquities have become a separation between you and your God, And your sins have hidden His face From you so that He does not hear. [M]
- Heb. 9:22b And without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness. [M]
- **Leviticus 17:11** For the life of the flesh is in the blood; and I have given it to you to make expiation for your souls on the altar, for it is the blood, by reason of the life, that makes expiation.
- **Genesis 3:21** And Jehovah God made coats of skins for Adam and for his wife and clothed them.
- **John 1:29b** Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!
- **Isaiah 53:6** All we like sheep have gone astray; Each of us has turned to his own way, and Jehovah has caused the iniquity of us all to fall on Him.
- 1 Peter 2:24 Who Himself bore up our sins in His body on the tree, in order that we, having died to sins, might live to righteousness; by whose bruise you were healed. [M]

- Exo. 12:13m ...when I see the blood, I will pass over you....
- Genesis 4:10–11 And He said, What have you done? The voice of your brother's blood is crying out to Me from the ground. And now you are cursed from the ground, which has opened its mouth to receive your brother's blood from your hand.
- **Hebrews 9:12** And not through the blood of goats and calves but through His own blood, entered once for all into the Holy of Holies, obtaining an eternal redemption.
- **Hebr. 12:24** And to Jesus, the Mediator of a new covenant; and to the blood of sprinkling, which speaks something better than that of Abel.
- Acts 3:19 Repent therefore and turn, that your sins may be wiped away.
- Acts 2:37–38 And when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and they said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, What should we do, brothers? And Peter said to them, Repent and each one of you be baptized upon the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
- 1 Tim. 1:19 Holding faith and a good conscience, concerning which some, thrusting these away, have become shipwrecked regarding the faith. [M]

Message Two

The Cleansing Blood

- **Jeremiah 17:9** The heart is deceitful above all things, / And it is incurable; / Who can know it?
- **Psalm 14:2–3** Jehovah looked down from heaven upon the sons of men, To see if there was anyone who had insight, who seeks after God. They have all turned aside; they are all together perverse. There is none who does good; there is not even one.
- **Isaiah. 64:6** For all of us became like him who is unclean And all our righteousnesses are like a soiled garment; And we all wither like a leaf; And our iniquities, like the wind, carry us away.
- **Proverbs 20:9** Who can say, I have made my heart clean; I am pure from my sin?
- **Proverbs 30:11–12** There is a generation that curses their father, and does not bless their mother; there is a generation that are pure in their own eyes, yet are not washed from their filthiness.
- **Proverbs 28:13** He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy. [M]

- **Psalm 51:2–4a** Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and from my sin cleanse me. 3 For I do know my transgressions, and my sin is before me continually. 4 Against You and You alone have I sinned, and I have done what is evil in Your sight.... [M v2]
- **Psalm 51:7** Purge my sin with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow.
- **Jeremiah 4:14** Wash your heart from wickedness, O Jerusalem, / That you may be saved. / How long will your evil thoughts / Lodge within you?
- **Hebrews 9:22** And almost all things are purified by blood according to the law, and without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.
- **1 John 1:9** If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. *[M]*
- **Revelation 1:5** ...To Him who loves us and has released us from our sins by His blood.
- 1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from every sin. [M]
- **Hebrews 9:14** How much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God? [B]
- **Hebrews 10:22** Let us come forward to the Holy of Holies with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. [B]
- **Zechariah 13:1** In that day there will be an opened fountain for the house of David and for the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for sin and for impurity. [M]
- **Revelation 7:14–15** And I said to him, My lord, you know. And he said to me, These are those who come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. Because of this they are before the throne of God and serve Him day and night in His temple; and He who sits upon the throne will tabernacle over them.
- **Revelation 22:14** Blessed are those who wash their robes that they may have right to the tree of life and may enter by the gates into the city.
- **Revelation 22:3** And there will no longer be a curse. And the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and His slaves will serve Him.



Message Three

The Blood of the Covenant

- Jer. 31:31–34 Indeed, days are coming, declares Jehovah, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah, 32 Not like the covenant which I made with their fathers in the day I took them by their hand to bring them out from the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, although I was their Husband, declares Jehovah. 33 But this is the covenant which I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares Jehovah: I will put My law in their inward parts and write it upon their hearts; and I will be their God, and they will be My people. 34 And they will no longer teach, each man his neighbor and each man his brother, saying, Know Jehovah; for all of them will know Me, from the little one among them even to the great one among them, declares Jehovah, for I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more.
- Heb. 10:16–22 "This is the covenant which I will covenant with them after those days, says the Lord: I will impart My laws upon their hearts, and upon their mind I will inscribe them," 17 He then says, "And their sins and their lawlessnesses I shall by no means remember anymore." 18 Now where forgiveness of these is, there is no longer an offering for sin. 19 Having therefore, brothers, boldness for entering the Holy of Holies in the blood of Jesus, 20 Which entrance He initiated for us as a new and living way through the veil, that is, His flesh, 21 And having a great Priest over the house of God, 22 Let us come forward to the Holy of Holies with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water.
- **John 13:1** Now before the Feast of the Passover, Jesus knowing that His hour had come for Him to depart out of this world unto the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the uttermost.
- **Rom. 8:2** For the law of the Spirit of life has freed me in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and of death.
- **Rom. 8:4** That the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the spirit.
- **Gal. 2:20** I am crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live in faith, the faith of the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.
- Phil. 1:21a For to me, to live is Christ....
- Songs 2:16a My beloved is mine, and I am his.
- **Phil. 3:10** To know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death.
- Eph. 3:18–19 May be full of strength to apprehend with all the saints

- what the breadth and length and height and depth are 19 And to know the knowledge-surpassing love of Christ, that you may be filled unto all the fullness of God.
- **Psa. 103:12** As far as the east is from the west, / So far has He removed our transgressions from us.
- 1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from every sin.
- Matt. 26:28 For this is My blood of the covenant, which is being poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.
- **Luke 22:20** And similarly the cup after they had dined, saying, This cup is the new covenant established in My blood, which is being poured out for you.
- 1 Cor. 11:25 Similarly also the cup after they had dined, saying, This cup is the new covenant established in My blood; this do, as often as you drink it, unto the remembrance of Me.
- Heb. 9:14-22 How much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God? 15 And because of this He is the Mediator of a new covenant, so that, death having taken place for redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, those who have been called might receive the promise of the eternal inheritance. 16 For where there is a testament, the death of him who made the testament must of necessity be established. 17 For a testament is confirmed in the case of the dead, since it never has force when he who made the testament is living. 18 Hence neither was the first covenant initiated without blood; 19 For when every commandment according to the law had been spoken by Moses to all the people, he took the blood of the calves and the goats, with water and scarlet wool and hyssop, and sprinkled both the scroll of the covenant itself and all the people, 20 Saying, "This is the blood of the covenant which God has commanded to you." 21 And both the tabernacle and all the vessels of the service he sprinkled in like manner with the blood. 22 And almost all things are purified by blood according to the law, and without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.
- Matt. 26:28 For this is My blood of the covenant, which is being poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.
- **Heb. 13:15** Through Him then let us offer up a sacrifice of praise continually to God, that is, the fruit of lips confessing His name.
- **Psa. 50:23** Whoever offers a sacrifice of thanksgiving glorifies Me; / And to him who sets his way right I will show the salvation of God.
- **Luke 22:19** And He took a loaf and gave thanks, and He broke it and gave it to them, saying, This is My body which is being given for you; do this in remembrance of Me.

- 1 Cor. 11:23–26 For I received from the Lord that which also I delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread, 24 And having given thanks, He broke it and said, This is My body, which is given for you; this do unto the remembrance of Me. 25 Similarly also the cup after they had dined, saying, This cup is the new covenant established in My blood; this do, as often as you drink it, unto the remembrance of Me. 26 For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you declare the Lord's death until He comes.
- 1 Cor. 11:27–28 So then whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of the body and of the blood of the Lord. 28 But let a man prove himself, and in this way let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup.
- Acts 4:24 And when they heard this, they lifted up their voice with one accord to God and said, Sovereign Master, You are the One who has made heaven and earth and the sea and all things in them.

Message Four

The Redeeming Blood

- **Isaiah 50:1e** Behold, through your iniquities have you sold yourselves.
- **Rom. 5:21** In order that just as sin reigned in death, so also grace might reign through righteousness unto eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Rom. 6:6b ...we should no longer serve sin as slaves.
- **Rom. 6:12** Do not let sin therefore reign in your mortal body so that you obey the body's lusts.
- **Rom. 6:16** Do you not know that to whom you present yourselves as slaves for obedience, his slaves you are whom you obey, whether of sin unto death or of obedience unto righteousness?
- **John 8:34** Jesus answered them, Truly, truly, I say to you, Everyone who commits sin is a slave of sin.
- 1 Pet. 1:13–19 Therefore girding up the loins of your mind and being sober, set your hope perfectly on the grace being brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ. 14 As children of obedience, do not be fashioned according to the former lusts in your ignorance; 15 But according to the Holy One who called you, you yourselves also be holy in all your manner of life; 16 Because it is written, "You shall be holy because I am holy." 17 And if you call as Father the One who without respect of persons judges according to each one's work, pass the time of your sojourning in fear, 18 Knowing that it was not with corruptible things, with silver or gold, that you were redeemed

- from your vain manner of life handed down from your fathers, 19 But with precious blood, as of a Lamb without blemish and without spot, the blood of Christ. [M 15, 17b, 18-19]
- **Rom. 1:21** Because though they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God or thank Him, but rather became vain in their reasonings, and their heart, lacking understanding, was darkened.
- **Rom. 1:25** Who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshipped and served the creation rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen.
- Rom. 1:24, 26a Therefore God gave them up in the lusts of their hearts to uncleanness, so that they dishonor their bodies among themselves....26a Therefore God gave them up to passions of dishonor....
- **Rev. 1:5b** To Him [Jesus Christ] who loves us and has released us from our sins by His blood.
- Acts 14:15 And saying, Men, why are you doing these things? We also are men of like feeling as you, and announce the gospel to you that you should turn from these vain things to the living God, who made heaven and earth and the sea and all things in them.
- Acts 20:28 Take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among whom the Holy Spirit has placed you as overseers to shepherd the church of God, which He obtained through His own blood.
- **John 18:38b** And having said this, he [Pilate] again went out to the Jews and said to them, I find no fault in Him.
- **Isa. 53:5** But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.
- Rev. 5:9b ... You were slain and have purchased for God by Your blood men out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation.
- 1 Cor. 6:19-20 Or do you not know that...you are not your own? 20 For you have been bought with a price. So then glorify God in your body. [M]

Message Five


The Victorious Blood

- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober; watch. Your adversary, the devil, as a roaring lion, walks about, seeking someone to devour.
- Job 1:6-9 6 Then one day, when the sons of God came to present themselves before Jehovah, Satan also came among them. 7 And

Jehovah said to Satan, Where have you come from? And Satan answered Jehovah and said, From roving the earth and going about in it. 8 And Jehovah said to Satan, Have you considered My servant Job? For there is none like him on the earth, a perfect and upright man, one who fears God, and turns away from evil. 9 Then Satan answered Jehovah, and said, Does Job fear God without cause?
