RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **The conference schedule must be followed by everyone.**
2. Attendance at all meetings (including cabin times and morning revival) is mandatory. In case of sickness, appropriate medical attention will be obtained and parents may be asked to come take the sick child home.
3. During cabin times, everyone will be encouraged to participate.
4. No one may leave the camp grounds at any time.
5. We would like to give the entire weekend to the Lord with no distractions. Please avoid cell phone use except to access Bible verses and hymns for the meetings, and turn off cell phones in between meetings. Please keep phones on silent during meetings. No other electronic items are allowed (radios, tablets, music players, games, etc.). **Please bring your printed Bible and hymn book to the meetings.**
6. No novels or magazines are permitted, only spiritual reading materials or homework. This includes the rides to and from the camp. Homework material may **not** include novels or other types of fiction.
7. Brothers are not permitted in the areas of the sisters' lodging, and sisters are not permitted in the areas the brothers are occupying.
8. All clothing worn during the entire weekend must be proper and modest. **No sleeveless, low cut, skin-tight or skin-revealing shirts may be worn. No shorts, pants that sag, hip-hugger or low rise pants may be worn. No clothing, caps, or shirts with improper pictures, logos, or symbols may be worn. This applies to brothers and sisters.** [Please read: Watchman Nee, *Messages for Building Up New Believers*, vol. 3, chapter 37].
9. All **Camp Regulations** must be observed. For example, no alcohol, tobacco, fireworks, firearms, knives, illegal drugs, flammable liquids, explosives, poisonous substances, or cliff climbing are permitted at the camp. *Fighting* – All forms of physical violence are expressly forbidden and are grounds for immediate expulsion of the offending parties and possible criminal charges being filed. *Profanity / Vulgar Speech* – will not be tolerated at any time.
10. Snacks and food are not allowed in the bedrooms.
11. Due to fire danger, candle usage will not be allowed in any building.
12. **All attendees must follow the instructions of the serving ones.**

Message One

A Vision of God's Building *and* The Church as God's Called-Out Assembly

Ephesians 1:17–23 **That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the full knowledge of Him,** 18 The eyes of your heart having been enlightened, that you may know what is the hope of His calling, and what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, 19 And what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the operation of the might of His strength, 20 Which He caused to operate in Christ in raising Him from the dead and seating Him at His right hand in the heavenlies, 21 Far above all rule and authority and power and lordship and every name that is named not only in this age but also in that which is to come; 22 And He subjected all things under His feet and gave Him to be Head over all things to the church, 23 Which is His Body, the fullness of the One who fills all in all.

Proverbs 29:18 Where there is no vision, the people cast off restraint; / But happy is he who keeps the law.

Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed / Because of a lack of that knowledge. / For you have rejected that knowledge, / And I will reject you, so that you will not be a priest to Me; / Since you have forgotten the law of your God, / I also will forget your children.

Message Two

The Church is the House of God

Ephesians 2:19–22 So then you are no longer strangers and sojourners, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God. 20 Being built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the cornerstone; **21 In whom all the building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord; 22 in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling place of God in spirit.**

1 Timothy 3:14–15 These things I write to you, hoping to come to you shortly. **15 But if I delay, I write that you may know how one ought to conduct himself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and base of the truth.**

1 John 5:1 Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ has been begotten of God, and everyone who loves Him who has begotten loves him also who has been begotten of Him.

John 17:21 That they all may be one; even as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us; that the world may believe that You have sent Me.

Haggai 1:3–4 Then the word of Jehovah came through Haggai the prophet, saying, 4 Is it time for you yourselves to dwell in your paneled-up houses, while this house lies waste?

But let each man take heed how he builds upon it. **11 For another foundation no one is able to lay besides that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.** 12 But if anyone builds upon the foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, grass, stubble, 13 The work of each will become manifest; for the day will declare it, because it is revealed by fire, and the fire itself will prove each one's work, of what sort it is. 14 If anyone's work which he has built upon the foundation remains, he will receive a reward; 15 If anyone's work is consumed, he will suffer loss, but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire. 16 Do you not know that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

1 Corinthians 6:19 Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?

1 Corinthians 14:1, 3–4 Pursue love, and desire earnestly spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy....3 But he who prophesies speaks building up and encouragement and consolation to men. 4 He who speaks in a tongue builds up himself, but he who prophesies builds up the church.

1 Corinthians 14:12b ...Seek that you may excel for the building up of the church.

Message Three

The Church is the Body of Christ and the Bride of Christ

Ephesians 5:23b ...Christ is Head of the church, He Himself being the Savior of the Body.

1 Corinthians 12:12–13 For even as the body is one and has many members, yet all the members of the body, being many, are one body, so also is the Christ. 13 For also in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and were all given to drink one Spirit.

Romans 12:4–5 For just as in one body we have many members, and all the members do not have the same function, 5 So we who are many are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another.

Ephesians 1:22–23 And He subjected all things under His feet and gave Him to be Head over all things to the church, 23 Which is His Body, the fullness of the One who fills all in all.

Ephesians 2:16 And might reconcile both in one Body to God through the cross, having slain the enmity by it.

Ephesians 3:3–4, 6a That by revelation the mystery was made known to me, as I have written previously in brief, 4 By which, in reading it, you can perceive my understanding in the mystery of Christ,...6 That in Christ Jesus the Gentiles are fellow heirs and fellow members of the Body....

Ephesians 3:19b ...that you may be filled unto all the fullness of God.

Ephesians 4:11–13, 15–16 And He Himself gave some as apostles and some as prophets and some as evangelists and some as shepherds and teachers, 12 For the perfecting of the saints unto the work of the ministry, unto the building up of the Body of Christ, 13 Until we all arrive at the oneness of the faith and of the full knowledge of the Son of God, at a full-grown man, at the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ,...**15 But holding to truth in love, we may grow up into Him in all things, who is the Head, Christ, 16 Out from whom all the Body, being joined together and being knit together through every joint of the rich supply and through the operation in the measure of each one part, causes the growth of the Body unto the building up of itself in love.**

Ephesians 5:29–30 For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, even as Christ also the church, 30 Because we are members of His Body.

Acts 9:4–5 And he fell on the ground and heard a voice saying to him, Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me? 5 And he said, Who are You, Lord? And He said, I am Jesus, whom you persecute.

Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live in faith, the faith of the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

Ephesians 5:25b–27 ...Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her that He might sanctify her, cleansing her by the washing of the water in the word, that He might present the church to Himself glorious, not having spot or wrinkle or any such things, but that she would be holy and without blemish.

Romans 5:8 But God commends His own love to us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Appendix
Seven Minutes Alone with the Lord

NOTE: The key is to do this *first thing* in the morning, routinely, and whether you feel like it or not! *Do not be distracted* by anything: any thoughts or feelings within, or any persons around you. As this becomes your habit, feel free to pray the prayers in your own words, modify as you like, and/or write new prayers down.

1 Begin by calling on the name of the Lord eight times, from deep within, out loud, “Oh Lord Jesus, I love You!”

2 Pray the following prayer form your heart, audibly, so your own ears can hear, even if softly: “Lord Jesus, I come to You with an open heart. Lord, open your Word to me right now, speak to me and shine on me.”

3 Pray-read two to three of your memory verses aloud, applying the contents of the verses to yourself.

4 Confess at least two or three sins specifically out loud (but not so loud that others nearby can hear them), even mentioning the details and motives, according to the Lord’s enlightening in your conscience.

5 Continue praying and confessing, with your heart, applying and making each of these prayers personal:

“O Lord Jesus, cleanse me with Your precious blood and forgive me of every sin. Thank you, Lord, for Your cleansing blood. O Lord, I forgive every person who has hurt or offended me, just as You have forgiven me.”

“Lord Jesus, I give you this day. Fill me today with Your Holy Spirit and take full control of my life. O Lord Jesus thank you that You are the Spirit mingled with my spirit. Lord Jesus, make Your home a little more in my heart today. Lord, I want You to be on the throne. Lord, although I am weak and oftentimes stubborn and rebellious, by faith I say that I am willing to be made willing to do Your will in every matter in my life. O Lord Jesus, I need You and I love You.”

“O Father, Abba Father, give to me today a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the full knowledge of Christ. May the eyes of my heart be enlightened that I may know what is the hope of Your calling, what are the riches of the glory of Your inheritance in the saints, even in me, and what is the surpassing greatness of Your power which is toward me by believing. Father, grant me to be strengthened with power through Your Spirit into my inner man, that Christ may make His home in my heart through faith, that I may be filled unto all the fullness of God” (Eph 1:17-19 & 3:16-17, 19b).

“Lord Jesus, I give all my thoughts to You. Renew my mind more today. Bring all of my thoughts fully captive to You.”

“Lord, strengthen my will to obey You a little more today. Lord, cause me to love You more today, to love what You love and hate what You hate, to love the light and hate the darkness. Lord, increase my hunger and love for Your Word.”

“Lord, grant me a healthy conscience. Help me take care of my conscience and live under a clear sky. Lord Jesus, grant me a clear vision of Your economy and Your eternal purpose. Lord, strengthen my faith in You.”

“Lord Jesus, save me from the broad way that leads to destruction. Lord deliver me from evil and from evil persons. Do not lead me into temptation. Lord, I admit I am weak and I often fail. Lord, preserve me from all the damaging things of this world. Lord preserve me, spirit, soul, and body, in Your will and for Your purpose. O Lord Jesus, help me to learn the lessons that I need to learn. Grant me the wisdom to live a proper human life.”

“O Lord Jesus, be with me today, be real to me today, and do everything in me today. Lord Jesus, I love You.”

“Lord, bless and protect my family. Bless all the saints in the church. Lord, help me to pray more for others.” (You can pray for specific family members or saints in the church, or for other young people in this conference.)

“Lord Jesus, I praise and thank You for all things that You have allowed in my life, even though I don’t understand everything. I believe in You and I trust You. I believe that Your heart is good toward me. Lord, I believe that You can and will work all things together for good, for Your glory and for Your purpose. Lord, thank you for dying for me, for living in me and for loving me so much. Lord Jesus, thank You for everything. O Lord Jesus, I really love You and I praise You! Amen!”

6 Pray, by name, for at least three people – for their salvation, revival, healing, or other spiritual blessings for them.

7 Pray from your heart about other things and matters that you feel you should pray about, including events and things coming up in your life that day, or other matters to confess before God.

After spending these seven minutes with the Lord, if you have time, you can take a couple of minutes for your daily Bible reading. If you don’t have time in the morning, read your Bible consecutively before going to bed at night.
